# **Background:**

Possible landing gear actuator failure to lock during an emergency gear extension can occur.

Any of the following group of landing gear actuators, manufactured between July and August 2014 may have been improperly adjusted when assembled. This could become critical during an emergency gear freefall procedure without hydraulic power. The actuator could fail to fully extend or could fully extend but not lock. This condition would be during an emergency extension only. It does not apply to a normal gear down operation.

We have identified 14 actuators with possible locking issues. Please check the serial numbers on your actuators against the following list.
